2015-2016 After Care Program

- Purpose:** The St. Patrick School After Care program provides a safe environment where children have opportunities to socialize, study to complete school assignments, and participate in various activities.
- Who:** Child care is provided for students attending St. Patrick School (PS3-6th). PS3 students may participate only in conjunction with the Tuesday/Thursday Surround Care program.
- Time:** Monday – Friday (on the days school is in session), 3:00-5:30 p.m.
- Enrollment:** Registration forms are to be completed for students to be admitted to the After Care program. Parents commit to the number of days that their child(ren) will be placed in the After Care program. Written notification is needed when a family chooses to change schedule and/or discontinue child care services.
- Fee Schedule:** The St. Patrick School After Care program is financed entirely by program participation fees. The fee schedule for the 2015-2016 school year is below:

Child care fees are paid monthly. Checks are to be made payable to Aquinas Catholic Schools (ACS). Child care services may be discontinued for families who do not keep current with payment of child care fees.

- Guidelines:** Students will proceed to the After Care program at the end of the school day. Student attendance will be taken each day. Students will be signed out by parents at the time of pick-up. Pick-up location is the lower parking lot, door F.

Children will be provided a healthy snack at the beginning of the program. Healthy snacks will be provided by the After Care program. The program utilizes the cafeteria for the first 30-45 minutes. During this time, homework and skill building activities will be provided for all age levels. Other locations of use inside or outside will be posted by the sign-out bin.

Parents will be called when a child has vomited, has diarrhea, or has a fever above 99 degrees. Parent or emergency contact person will need to pick up the child immediately.

- Behavior:** Expectations for student behavior during the After Care program are the same as during the school day. St. Patrick School and After Care staff reserve the right to discontinue services to students and families when student misbehaviors occur during the program.
